RETIREMENT OF HON CHRISTOPHER PYNE MP

The Submarine Institute of Australia (SIA) acknowledges the significant contribution that Hon Christopher Pyne MP has made as Minister for Defence, Minister for Defence Industry and to Australian submarines, in particular.

This follows confirmation that after 26 years in Parliament, Mr Pyne will retire from politics at the upcoming federal election.

"Also, the SIA would like to congratulate Senator the Hon Linda Reynolds CSC on her appointment as the new Minister for Defence Industry."
